10	An Act relating to anemometer towers; defining terms;
11	requiring certain markings for anemometer towers in certain locations; stating effective dates; requiring
12	certain markings for towers, guy wires and facilities; authorizing Commission to promulgate
13	rules; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
17	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
18	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 121 of Title 3, unless there is
19	created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
20	A. For purposes of this act, the term "anemometer" means an
21	instrument for measuring and recording the speed of wind. The term
22	"anemometer tower" means a structure, including all guy wires and
23	accessory facilities, on which an anemometer is mounted. The term
24	"Commission" means the Oklahoma Aeronautics Commission.

B. In addition to any zoning requirements of the Airport Zoning Act or the Aircraft Pilot and Passenger Protection Act, any anemometer tower that is fifty (50) feet in height above the ground or higher, that is located outside the exterior boundaries of any municipality, and whose appearance is not otherwise mandated by state or federal law shall be marked, painted, flagged, or otherwise constructed to be recognizable in clear air during daylight hours.

- C. Any anemometer tower erected before the effective date of this act shall be marked as required herein within one year following the effective date of this act. Any anemometer tower erected on or after the effective date of this act shall be marked as required herein at the time it is erected.
- D. Marking as required by this act shall include marking the anemometer tower, guy wires, and accessory facilities as follows:
- 1. The entire anemometer tower shall be painted in seven equal, alternating bands of aviation orange and white, beginning with orange at the top of the tower and with orange at the bottom of the tower;
- 2. Two marker balls shall be attached to and evenly spaced on each of the outside guy wires; and
- 3. One seven-foot safety sleeve shall be placed at each anchor point and shall extend from the anchor point along each guy wire attached to the anchor point, with a second sleeve attached to the outer guy wire.

- E. The Commission shall establish and maintain a database that contains locations of all existing anemometer towers by November 1, 2015. The Commission may contract with a governmental entity or a private entity to create and maintain the database.
- 1. Within sixty (60) days after the effective date of this act, an owner of any anemometer tower erected in the state shall provide the Commission with information that specifies the owner and the tower's location, height, and other information that the Commission finds necessary for aviation safety.
- 2. At least ten (10) days before the erection of an anemometer tower, an owner of the tower shall provide the Commission with information that specifies the owner and the tower's location, height, and other information that the Commission finds necessary for aviation safety.
- 3. Within ten (10) days after the removal of an anemometer tower, an owner of the tower shall notify the Commission.
- F. The Commission may enforce this act and may promulgate any rules and administrative penalties necessary to implement the provisions of this act.
 - G. Violations of this act shall be prohibited.
