        Section 38. To protect agriculture as a vital sector of
    Oklahoma's economy, which provides food, energy, health benefits,

    and security and is the foundation and stabilizing force of
    Oklahoma's economy, the rights of farmers and ranchers to engage in

    farming and ranching practices shall be forever guaranteed in this

    state. The Legislature shall pass no law which unreasonably
