FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

[ schools - requiring school districts to conduct  
certain drills - effective date -  
emergency ]

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5-149 of Title 70, unless there  
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. In addition to the two lockdown drills required pursuant to  
Section 5-148 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes, all public  
schools shall conduct a minimum of eight safety drills as follows:

1. Two fire drills per school year. Each fire drill shall be  
conducted within the first fifteen (15) days of each semester. The  
fire drills shall include the sounding of a distinctive audible  
signal designated as the fire alarm signal;

1        2. Two intruder drills per school year. Intruder drills are  
2 conducted for the purpose of mitigating injuries or deaths by  
3 executing a plan as an alternative to the lockdown method. Each  
4 intruder drill shall be conducted within the first fifteen (15) days  
5 of each semester;

6        3. Two tornado drills per school year with at least one drill  
7 being conducted in the months of September and March; and

8        4. The principal and superintendent of a public school district  
9 shall utilize the remaining required safety drills in any manner  
10 provided in this section or Section 5-148 of Title 70 of the  
11 Oklahoma Statutes or by developing a drill that is consistent with  
12 the risks assessed for the appropriate facility or any  
13 recommendations submitted by the Safe School Committee as authorized  
14 pursuant to Section 24-100.5 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes or  
15 any assisting fire or law enforcement department.

16        B. It shall be the duty of the principal, under the direction  
17 of the superintendent of the school district, to conform to the  
18 written plans and procedures adopted by the district as required by  
19 Section 681 of Title 63 of the Oklahoma Statutes. All students and  
20 teachers at the public schools shall participate.

21        C. Each public school district shall document each fire drill  
22 in writing by public school site. The records for each fire drill  
23 shall be preserved for at least three years and made available to  
24 the State Fire Marshal or the marshal's agent upon request. In

1 addition to the fire drill documentation provided in this  
2 subsection, the school district shall document all other safety  
3 drills in writing and by school site with a copy of the report  
4 remaining at the school, a copy filed with the district  
5 administrative office and a copy with the Institute for School  
6 Security Resources as created by the Oklahoma Office of Homeland  
7 Security.

8 SECTION 2. REPEALER 63 O.S. 2011, Section 176, is hereby  
9 repealed.

10 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2013.

11 SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
12 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
13 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
14 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
