FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

[tanning - specifying requirements of tanning
facilities - codification - effective date]

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-1431 of Title 63, unless there
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. A tanning facility shall have an operator present during
operating hours who is sufficiently knowledgeable in the correct
operation of tanning devices used at the facility so that he or she
is able to inform and assist each customer in the proper use of the
tanning beds and check proof of age for persons under eighteen (18)
years of age using tanning devices.

B. Every person who uses a tanning facility shall sign a
written statement acknowledging that he or she has read and

1 understands the warnings before using the device and that he or she
2 agrees to use protective eyewear.

3 C. Persons under eighteen (18) years of age shall be required
4 to submit a written consent form signed by their parent or legal
5 guardian before using a tanning device. The consent form shall be
6 provided by the tanning facility upon the first tanning visit and
7 the required signatures shall be made in the presence of an employee
8 of the tanning facility. Such consent form shall contain a written
9 statement acknowledging that the parent or legal guardian and the
10 child has read and understands the warnings before using the device
11 and that he or she agrees to use protective eyewear. The consent
12 form, once signed by a parent or guardian on behalf of their child
13 for purposes of using a tanning device, shall be valid at the
14 tanning facility until revoked by the parent or guardian or until
15 the person attains eighteen (18) years of age. Proof of age shall
16 be satisfied with a driver license or other government issued
17 identification containing the date of birth and a photograph of the
18 individual.

19 D. For purposes of this section:

20 1. "Tanning device" means equipment that emits electromagnetic
21 radiation with wavelengths in the air that is used for tanning of
22 human skin and includes any accompanying items incidental to
23 operation of the tanning device; and

1 2. "Tanning facility" means any facility, whether independent
2 or part of a salon, health spa or any other facility, which provides
3 access to tanning devices but shall not include private residences
4 if access to tanning devices is provided without charge.

5 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2013.
