11 An Act relating to schools; authorizing school
12 districts to adopt a zero tolerance policy; providing
13 for codification; providing an effective date; and
14 declaring an emergency.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
18 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 24-101.5 of Title 70, unless
19 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

20 Each school district board of education may adopt a zero
21 tolerance policy for the school district which requires application
22 of and enforcement of a mandatory punishment, discipline or
23 reprimand for specific offenses.

24 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2014.

1 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
2 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
3 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
4 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
