17	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2011, Section 733, is

19	Section 733. A. Homicide is also justifiable when committed by
20	any person in either any of the following cases:
21	1. When resisting any attempt to murder such person, or to
22	commit any felony upon him, or upon or in any dwelling house in
23	which such person is; or,

1	2. When committed in the lawful defense of such person $_{\overline{\tau}}$ or of
2	his or her husband, wife, parent, child, master, mistress, or
3	servant another, when there is a reasonable ground to apprehend a
4	design to commit the person using force reasonably believes such
5	force is necessary to prevent death or great bodily harm to himself
6	or herself or another or to terminate or prevent the commission of a
7	forcible felony, or to do some great personal injury, and imminent
8	danger of such design being accomplished; or,
9	3. When necessarily committed in attempting, by lawful ways and
10	means, to apprehend any person for any felony committed; or in
11	lawfully suppressing any riot; or in lawfully keeping and preserving
12	the peace.
13	B. As used in this section, "forcible felony" means any felony
14	which involves the use or threat of physical force or violence
15	against any person.
16	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2014.
