9                               COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

10                   An Act relating to counties and county officers;  
11                   amending 19 O.S. 2011, Section 130.4, which relates  
12                   to training programs for county officers; authorizing  
13                   Cooperative Extension Service to establish  
14                   examination and accreditation system for certain  
15                   persons; authorizing fee for training and  
16                   accreditation; and providing an effective date.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18                   SECTION 1.           AMENDATORY           19 O.S. 2011, Section 130.4, is  
19                   amended to read as follows:

20                   Section 130.4   A.   The Cooperative Extension Service is hereby  
21                   authorized to create advisory boards as they deem necessary.  
22                   Members of such advisory boards shall be appointed by the  
23                   Cooperative Extension Service and shall include, but shall not be  
24                   limited to, county government officials and appropriate state agency  
                    representatives. Meetings of advisory boards shall be called by the

1 County Training Program Director of the Cooperative Extension  
2 Service. Such advisory boards shall assist in developing  
3 educational programs and materials for training county government  
4 officers and their employees.

5 Advisory board members shall be reimbursed for expenses incurred  
6 in the performance of their duties under Sections 130.1 through  
7 130.7 of this title in accordance with the State Travel  
8 Reimbursement Act.

9 B. The Cooperative Extension Service is authorized to contract  
10 with state agencies and private entities to provide training.

11 C. The Cooperative Extension Service is authorized to:

12 1. Establish and maintain a procedure or system for the  
13 examination and accreditation of county officers, candidates for  
14 county office or any other person;

15 2. Establish a registration system and adopt and enforce  
16 standards for the training, examination and accreditation of county  
17 officers, candidates for county office, or any other person; and

18 3. Charge a fee, not to exceed One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00)  
19 per course, to any person seeking training and accreditation from  
20 the Cooperative Extension Service.

21 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2014.
