## 1 HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES - FLOOR VERSION 2 STATE OF OKLAHOMA 3 1st Session of the 54th Legislature (2013) HOUSE CONCURRENT 4 RESOLUTION 1010 By: McCall of the House 5 and 6 Brecheen of the Senate 7 8 9 10 AS INTRODUCED 11 A Concurrent Resolution approving the transfer of certain personal property and real property under the jurisdiction of the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation 12 Commission to certain government entity; specifying 1.3 that certain rights shall be retained; making the transfer subject to certain authority and 14 requirements; and providing for distribution. 15 16 17 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 1ST SESSION OF 18 THE 54TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN: 19 THAT, for purposes of public recreation and historic 20 preservation of a location of particular interest to both the State 21 of Oklahoma and the Chickasaw Nation and pursuant to Section 2224 of 22 Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the Oklahoma Legislature hereby 23 approves the transfer of real property containing approximately 24 588.5 acres and associated personal property at the area known as

1	Boggy Depot State Park owned by the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation
2	Department and operated and maintained under the jurisdiction of the
3	Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Commission to the Chickasaw Nation,
4	an American Indian tribe properly considered an "agency of
5	government" per the above-referenced statute and which is also an
6	eligible sponsor for land and water conservation funds under the
7	federal Land and Water Conservation Fund program.
8	THAT, of the real and personal property transferred, all mineral
9	rights shall be retained by the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation
10	Department or the State of Oklahoma.
11	THAT the real and personal property transfer shall be subject to
12	the authority and requirements in Section 2224 of Title 74 of the
13	Oklahoma Statutes.
14	THAT copies of this resolution be distributed to the Governor,
15	the Lieutenant Governor, the Attorney General, the Oklahoma Tourism
16	and Recreation Commission, the Executive Director of the Oklahoma
17	Tourism and Recreation Department and the Governor of the Chickasaw
18	Nation.
