6	components thereof, for security, defense of his home, person, or
7	property, or in aid of the civil power, when thereunto legally

9	purpose shall never be prohibited; but nothing herein contained
10	shall prevent the Legislature from regulating the carrying of
11	weapons not be infringed. Regulations of this right shall be
