18	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2011, Section 1290.13, as
19	amended by Section 33, Chapter 259, O.S.L. 2012 (21 O.S. Supp. 2012,
20	Section 1290.13), is amended to read as follows:

1	state pursuant to the provisions of the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act
2	and all subsequent suspended or revoked licenses. Information from
3	the automated listing shall only be available to a law enforcement
4	officer or law enforcement agency upon request for law enforcement
5	purposes. The Bureau shall also maintain for each applicant the
6	original application or a copy of the original application form and
7	any subsequent renewal application forms together with the
8	photographs, fingerprints and other pertinent information on the
9	applicant which shall be confidential, except to law enforcement
10	officers or law enforcement agencies in the performance of their
11	duties. The Bureau may release a copy of fingerprints of a deceased
12	applicant maintained by the Bureau due to an application for a
13	handgun license pursuant to the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act.
14	Provided, however, the Bureau may release a copy of fingerprints of
15	a deceased applicant only to an immediate family member upon written
16	request. Such request shall be accompanied by a payment of Fifteen
17	Dollars (\$15.00), which shall be deposited into the OSBI Revolving
18	Fund. For purposes of this section, "immediate family member" shall
19	mean the spouse, a child by birth or adoption, a stepchild, a parent
20	by birth or adoption, a stepparent, a grandparent, a grandchild, a
21	sibling, a stepsibling or the spouse of any immediate family member.
22	To facilitate the Bureau's administration of the Oklahoma Self-
23	Defense Act, all licensees shall maintain a current mailing address
24	where the licensee may receive certified mail. The licensee shall
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1	within thirty (30) days of a change of name or address inform the
2	Bureau of such change.
