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16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
17	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 25 O.S. 2011, Section 314, is
18	amended to read as follows:
19	Section 314. <u>A.</u> Any person or persons willfully violating any
20	of the provisions of this act shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and
21	upon conviction shall be punished by a fine not exceeding Five
22	Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) or by imprisonment in the county jail for
23	a period not exceeding one (1) year or by both such fine and
24	imprisonment.

1	B. Following a violation of this act, any person:
2	1. May bring a civil suit for declarative or injunctive relief,
3	or both; and
4	2. If successful, shall be entitled to reasonable attorney
5	fees.
6	C. If the public body successfully defends a civil suit and the
7	court finds that the suit was clearly frivolous, the public body
8	shall be entitled to reasonable attorney fees.
9	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2014.
