11 An Act relating to animals; amending 4 O.S. 2011,
12 Sections 501 and 508, which relate to disposal of
13 animals held in shelter; removing administration of
14 carbon monoxide as an acceptable method of
15 euthanasia; removing certain approved methods as
16 acceptable methods of euthanasia; modifying
17 citations; repealing 4 O.S. 2011, Sections 503 and
18 504, which relate to carbon monoxide administration
19 and equipment; and providing an effective date.

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

21 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 4 O.S. 2011, Section 501, is
22 amended to read as follows:

23 Section 501. A. Any dog, cat or any other animal which is kept
24 for pleasure rather than utility in or about a household, held by or
25 in the custody of a private or public animal shelter or agency and
26 not reclaimed by the owner, may be disposed of only by:

1. Adoption as a pet in a suitable home;

1 2. Delivery to a licensed educational or research institution
2 in accordance with the provisions of Sections 391 through 402 of
3 this title; or

4 3. Euthanasia by only one of the following methods:

5 a. administration of denatured sodium pentobarbital, or

6 b. ~~the use of a carbon monoxide chamber, using~~
7 ~~commercially compressed cylinder gas; provided that~~
8 ~~kittens and puppies under sixteen (16) weeks of age~~
9 ~~shall not be euthanized with carbon monoxide but with~~
10 ~~injections of denatured sodium pentobarbital, or~~
11 ~~c. any other method approved by the Animal Industries~~
12 ~~Services Division of the State Department of~~
13 ~~Agriculture which shall include current acceptable~~
14 ~~euthanasia recommendations from the American~~
15 ~~Veterinary Medical Association, with the exception of~~
16 ~~curariform derivative drugs. The following~~
17 ~~requirements must be met to ensure the euthanasia~~
18 ~~agent is humane:~~

19 (1) the method should be as painless as possible to
20 the animal as determined by the best available
21 medical and scientific knowledge and technology,

22 (2) the animal should be kept as free from anxiety
23 and fear as possible,

24 (3) the technique should be:

- 1 (a) simple enough to be used by relatively
2 unskilled personnel,
3 (b) legally available to all animal shelters and
4 humane societies,
5 (c) as mechanically simple and maintenance free
6 as possible within reasonable cost, and
7 (d) physically safe for personnel using it.

8 B. Death should be confirmed by cessation of vital signs.

9 Professional judgment should be used in consideration of the animal
10 species and method of euthanasia to determine the means of
11 confirming death.

12 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 4 O.S. 2011, Section 508, is
13 amended to read as follows:

14 Section 508. The provisions of Sections ~~4~~ 502 through ~~7~~ 507 of
15 this ~~act~~ title shall not apply to any municipality with a population
16 of ten thousand (10,000) or less persons according to the latest
17 Federal Decennial Census. However, unclaimed animals must be
18 destroyed by an acceptable, humane method.

19 SECTION 3. REPEALER 4 O.S. 2011, Sections 503 and 504,
20 are hereby repealed.

21 SECTION 4. This act shall become effective November 1, 2014.
