NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 51.2d of Title 74, unless there 17 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 18 Upon the effective date of this act, the Oklahoma Office of 19 Homeland Security shall designate a division of their office as the 20 "Oklahoma School Security Institute". 21 The Oklahoma School Security Institute shall act as the 22 central repository for the public and private elementary and 23

secondary schools of this state to contact for information on

- 3 | The goals and objectives of the Oklahoma School Security Institute

- 2. Assisting and coordinating with public and private

- 4. Creating and coordinating any working groups when necessary
- 15 in order to continue developing and implementing new strategies and
- 16 techniques for future recommendations on school security issues.
- 17 C. The Oklahoma School Security Institute may develop a
- 18 | telephone tip line whereby reports of activity that may compromise
- 19 | school safety can be called in and disseminated to the appropriate
- 20 parties for additional investigation should it be warranted.
- 21 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2013.
- 22 | SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
- 23 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
