10 COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

11 An Act relating to elections; amending 26 O.S. 2011,
12 Section 5-111, as amended by Section 2, Chapter 10,
13 O.S.L. 2012 (26 O.S. Supp. 2012, Section 5-111),
14 which relates to forms for Declarations of Candidacy;
15 requiring certain candidates to provide certain
16 information; and providing an effective date.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 26 O.S. 2011, Section 5-111, as
18 amended by Section 2, Chapter 10, O.S.L. 2012 (26 O.S. Supp. 2012,
19 Section 5-111), is amended to read as follows:

20 Section 5-111. A. Forms to be used for filing Declarations of
21 Candidacy shall be prescribed by the Secretary of the State Election
22 Board and shall contain the following information:

23 1. The name of the candidate; ~~the~~

24 2. The candidate's place of residence and mailing address;

1 3. The name of the office sought; ~~the~~

2 4. The candidate's date of birth;

3 5. The party affiliation of candidate seeking political party
4 nomination;

5 6. The precinct and county wherein the candidate is a
6 registered voter; ~~an~~

7 7. An oath wherein the candidate swears or affirms that he or
8 she is qualified to become a candidate for the office sought, and
9 that, if elected, the candidate will be qualified to hold the
10 office; and ~~any~~

11 8. Any additional information which the Secretary deems
12 necessary.

13 B. If the candidate has ever been found guilty of a felony or
14 at the time of filing the Declaration of Candidacy is named in an
15 outstanding warrant for arrest, in this or any other state, the
16 candidate shall provide the following information on a form
17 prescribed by the Secretary of the State Election Board:

18 1. The name of the offense;

19 2. The date of conviction or issuance of the outstanding
20 warrant; and

21 3. The county and state of conviction or issuance of the
22 outstanding warrant.

1 C. A Declaration of Candidacy form must be signed by the
2 candidate, and the signature must be properly notarized by a notary
3 public or other person authorized by law to administer oaths.

4 D. In addition to the information required by this section, a
5 candidate may include a telephone number, ~~email~~ e-mail address and
6 website address. Such additional information shall not be required
7 of any candidate but if provided shall be made available to the
8 public.

9 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2013.
