12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
13	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 593 of Title 21, unless there is
15	created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
16	A. It shall be unlawful for a CLEET-certified peace officer to
17	request, receive or accept cash payment in the field for any fine,
18	cost, assessment or fee related to a state law violation.
19	B. Any law enforcement officer who violates the provisions of
20	this section shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a misdemeanor
21	punishable by imprisonment in the county jail not exceeding one (1)
22	year, or by a fine not exceeding Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), or
23	by both such fine and imprisonment.
