BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 593 of Title 21, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. It shall be unlawful for a CLEET-certified peace officer to request, receive or accept cash payment in the field for any fine, cost, assessment or fee related to a state law violation.

B. Any law enforcement officer who violates the provisions of this section shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment in the county jail not exceeding one (1) year, or by a fine not exceeding Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), or by both such fine and imprisonment.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2014.
