20	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND THE SENATE OF THE
21	2ND SESSION OF THE 54TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:
22	SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for
23	their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law,
24	

- 1 the following proposed amendment to Section 26 of Article II of the 2 Constitution of the State of Oklahoma to read as follows:
- 3 Section 26. A. The fundamental right of $\frac{1}{2}$ each individual
- 4 citizen to keep and to bear (that is, to carry) arms in defense of
- 5 his home, person, or property, or, including handguns, rifles,
- 6 | shotguns, knives, nonlethal defensive weapons and other arms in
- 7 | common use, as well as ammunition and the components of arms and
- 8 ammunition, for security, self-defense, lawful hunting and
- 9 recreation, in aid of the civil power, when thereunto legally
- 10 lawfully summoned, or for any other legitimate purpose shall never
- 11 | not be prohibited; but nothing herein contained shall prevent the
- 12 | Legislature from regulating the carrying of weapons infringed. Any
- 13 regulation of this right shall be subject to strict scrutiny.
- 14 B. This section shall not prevent the Legislature from
- 15 | prohibiting the possession of arms by convicted felons, those
- 16 adjudicated as mentally incompetent, or those who have been
- 17 | involuntarily committed in any mental institution.
- 18 C. No law shall impose registration or special taxation upon
- 19 the keeping of arms, including the acquisition, ownership,
- 20 possession, or transfer of arms, ammunition, or the components of
- 21 arms or ammunition.
- 22 | SECTION 2. The Ballot Title for the proposed Constitutional
- 23 amendment as set forth in SECTION 1 of this resolution shall be in
- 24 | the following form:

3	THE GIST OF THE PROPOSITION IS AS FOLLOWS:
4	This measure amends the State Constitution. This measure deals
5	with the right of a citizen to keep and bear arms. The change
6	to this section will make clear what types of weapons and for
7	what purpose the weapons may be kept. The change would also
8	clarify that regulations by the state on the right to keep and
9	bear arms shall be subject to strict scrutiny.

13	SECTION 3. The Chief Clerk of the House of Representatives,
