15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:								
16	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2011, Section 1290.13, as								
17	amended by Section 33, Chapter 259, O.S.L. 2012 (21 O.S. Supp. 2012,								
18	Section 1290.13), is amended to read as follows:

20	AUTOMATIC LISTING OF LICENSES								
21	The Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation shall maintain an								
22	automated listing of all persons issued a handgun license in this								
23	state pursuant to the provisions of the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act								

and all subsequent suspended or revoked licenses. Information from

1 the automated listing shall only be available to a law enforcement 2 officer or law enforcement agency upon request for law enforcement 3 purposes. The Bureau shall also maintain for each applicant the original application or a copy of the original application form and 4 5 any subsequent renewal application forms together with the photographs, fingerprints and other pertinent information on the 6 applicant which shall be confidential, except to law enforcement 7 officers or law enforcement agencies in the performance of their 8 9 duties. The Bureau may release a copy of fingerprints of a deceased 10 applicant maintained by the Bureau due to an application for a handgun license pursuant to the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act. 11 12 Provided, however, the Bureau may release a copy of fingerprints of a deceased applicant only to an immediate family member upon written 13 request. Such request shall be accompanied by a payment of Fifteen 14 15 Dollars (\$15.00), which shall be deposited into the OSBI Revolving 16 Fund. For purposes of this section, "immediate family member" shall mean the spouse, a child by birth or adoption, a stepchild, a parent 17 by birth or adoption, a stepparent, a grandparent, a grandchild, a 18 sibling, a stepsibling or the spouse of any immediate family member. 19 To facilitate the Bureau's administration of the Oklahoma Self-20 Defense Act, all licensees shall maintain a current mailing address 21 where the licensee may receive certified mail. The licensee shall 22 within thirty (30) days of a change of name or address inform the 23 Bureau of such change. 24
