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13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
14	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 26 O.S. 2011, Section 1-108, is
15	amended to read as follows:
16	Section 1-108. A. A group of persons may form a recognized
17	political party at any time except during the period between March 1
18	and November 15 of any even-numbered year if the following procedure
19	is observed:
20	1. Notice of intent to form a recognized political party must
21	be filed in writing with the Secretary of the State Election Board
22	at any time except during the period between March 1 and November 15
23	of any even-numbered year;
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- 1 2. After such notice is filed, petitions seeking recognition of 2 a political party, in a form to be prescribed by the Secretary of 3 the State Election Board, shall be filed with such Secretary, bearing the signatures of registered voters equal to at least five 4 5 percent (5%) of the total votes cast in the last General Election either for Governor or for electors for President and Vice 6 President. Each page of such the petitions must contain the names 7 of registered voters from a single county. Petitions may be 8 9 circulated a maximum of one (1) year after notice is filed, provided 10 that petitions shall be filed with the Secretary no later than March 11 1 of an even-numbered year. Such The petitions shall not be 12 circulated between March 1 and November 15 of any even-numbered year; and 13
 - 3. Within thirty (30) days after receipt of such petitions, the State Election Board shall determine the sufficiency of such petitions. If such the Board determines there are a sufficient number of valid signatures of registered voters, the party becomes recognized under the laws of the State of Oklahoma with all rights and obligations accruing thereto.
 - B. In the event a question or dispute arises as to which person or persons have the authority to act on behalf of a recognized political party, the Secretary of the State Election Board shall have the authority to make such determination based on relevant state statutes, official documents filed with the Secretary of the

2	consultation with the party's national chair or executive committee.
3	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2013.
