9 A Joint Resolution designating the Woodring Wall of
10 Honor and Veterans Park as the state's official
Vietnam War Memorial; and directing distribution.

13 WHEREAS, the American Veterans Traveling Tribute Vietnam
14 Memorial Wall has journeyed all across the country; and

15 WHEREAS, the Woodring Wall of Honor and Veterans Park in Enid,
16 Oklahoma, is a living memorial to veterans, past and present; and

17 WHEREAS, one of the walls displayed by the Texas-based veterans'
18 organization, a replica of the Vietnam Memorial in Washington, D.C.
19 and purchased through generous donations from the community, will be
20 placed on permanent display at Enid Woodring Regional Airport
21 adjacent to the Woodring Wall of Honor; and

22 WHEREAS, bringing the wall to Enid has been a communitywide
23 effort involving individuals, businesses and organizations; and

1 WHEREAS, the wall will be officially unveiled on Memorial Day
2 2013, and contains 58,272 names of those who lost their lives during
3 the Vietnam War, including 16 from Enid, Oklahoma.

4 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF
5 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 54TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

6 SECTION 1. The Legislature of the State of Oklahoma declares
7 the Woodring Wall of Honor and Veterans Park located in Enid,
8 Oklahoma, as the State of Oklahoma's official Vietnam War Memorial.

9 SECTION 2. The Secretary of State is hereby directed to
10 distribute copies of this resolution to the Governor, Lieutenant
11 Governor, Mayor of Enid, and the Secretary of the Oklahoma Veterans
12 Department.
