20	person anywhere in the state to use only for personal protection if
21	the person has successfully completed an approved course of firearm
22	firearms training conducted by a state-certified firearms instructor
23	which meets the minimum requirements for firearms training as set
24	forth by the Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training.
