6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to carrying of firearms; amending 19
8 O.S. 2011, Section 215.29, which relates to the
9 carrying of firearms by district attorneys; adding
10 certain persons who may carry a firearm; clarifying
11 language; and providing an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 19 O.S. 2011, Section 215.29, is
14 amended to read as follows:

15 Section 215.29. A. A district attorney, ~~or~~ a retired district
16 attorney who receives a statement from the appropriate retirement
17 system verifying the status of the person as a retired district
18 attorney, or a district attorney who does not seek reelection or has
19 been defeated in a reelection vote may carry a firearm on his or her
20 person anywhere in the state to use only for personal protection if
21 the person has successfully completed an approved course of ~~firearm~~
22 firearms training conducted by a state-certified firearms instructor
23 which meets the minimum requirements for firearms training as set
24 forth by the Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training.

1 B. ~~At the discretion of the district attorney, the~~ The district
2 attorney may allow an assistant district attorney to carry a firearm
3 on his or her person anywhere in the state to use only for personal
4 protection if the person has successfully completed an approved
5 course of ~~firearm~~ firearms training conducted by a state-certified
6 firearms instructor which meets the minimum requirements for
7 firearms training as set forth by the Council on Law Enforcement
8 Education and Training.

9 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2014.
