6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to release of a copy of fingerprints;
8 amending 21 O.S. 2011, Section 1290.13, as amended by
9 Section 33, Chapter 259, O.S.L. 2012 (21 O.S. Supp.
10 2013, Section 1290.13), which relates to automatic
11 listing of handgun licenses; authorizing the Oklahoma
12 State Bureau of Investigation to release a copy of
13 certain fingerprints under certain circumstances;
14 providing for certain payment; defining term; and
15 providing an effective date.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2011, Section 1290.13, as
18 amended by Section 33, Chapter 259, O.S.L. 2012 (21 O.S. Supp. 2012,
19 Section 1290.13), is amended to read as follows:

20 Section 1290.13.

21 AUTOMATIC LISTING OF LICENSES

22 The Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation shall maintain an
23 automated listing of all persons issued a handgun license in this
24 state pursuant to the provisions of the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act
and all subsequent suspended or revoked licenses. Information from
the automated listing shall only be available to a law enforcement
officer or law enforcement agency upon request for law enforcement

1 purposes. The Bureau shall also maintain for each applicant the
2 original application or a copy of the original application form and
3 any subsequent renewal application forms together with the
4 photographs, fingerprints and other pertinent information on the
5 applicant which shall be confidential, except to law enforcement
6 officers or law enforcement agencies in the performance of their
7 duties. The Bureau may release a copy of fingerprints of a deceased
8 applicant maintained by the Bureau due to an application for a
9 handgun license pursuant to the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act.
10 Provided, however, the Bureau may release a copy of fingerprints of
11 a deceased applicant only to an immediate family member upon written
12 request. Such request shall be accompanied by a payment of Fifteen
13 Dollars (\$15.00), which shall be deposited into the OSBI Revolving
14 Fund. For purposes of this section, "immediate family member" shall
15 mean the spouse, a child by birth or adoption, a stepchild, a parent
16 by birth or adoption, a stepparent, a grandparent, a grandchild, a
17 sibling, a stepsibling or the spouse of any immediate family member.
18 To facilitate the Bureau's administration of the Oklahoma Self-
19 Defense Act, all licensees shall maintain a current mailing address
20 where the licensee may receive certified mail. The licensee shall
21 within thirty (30) days of a change of name or address inform the
22 Bureau of such change.

23 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2014.
