6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to firearms; creating the Piers
8 Morgan Constitutional Right to Keep and Bear Arms
Without Infringement Act; providing short title;
9 amending 21 O.S. 2011, Section 1289.6, as amended by
Section 11, Chapter 259, O.S.L. 2012 (21 O.S. Supp.
10 2013, Section 1289.6), which relates to conditions
under which firearms may be carried; adding
11 condition; providing for noncodification; and
providing an effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
16 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

17 This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Piers Morgan
18 Constitutional Right to Keep and Bear Arms Without Infringement
19 Act".

20 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2011, Section 1289.6, as
21 amended by Section 11, Chapter 259, O.S.L. 2012 (21 O.S. Supp. 2013,
22 Section 1289.6), is amended to read as follows:

23 Section 1289.6.

24 CONDITIONS UNDER WHICH FIREARMS MAY BE CARRIED

1 A. A person shall be permitted to carry loaded and unloaded
2 shotguns, rifles and pistols, open and not concealed and without a
3 handgun license as authorized by the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act
4 pursuant to the following conditions:

5 1. When hunting animals or fowl;

6 2. During competition in or practicing in a safety or hunter
7 safety class, target shooting, skeet, trap or other recognized
8 sporting events;

9 3. During participation in or in preparation for a military
10 function of the state military forces to be defined as the Oklahoma
11 Army or Air National Guard, Federal Military Reserve and active
12 military forces;

13 4. During participation in or in preparation for a recognized
14 police function of either a municipal, county or state government as
15 functioning police officials;

16 5. During a practice for or a performance for entertainment
17 purposes;

18 6. For lawful self-defense and self-protection or any other
19 legitimate purpose in or on property that is owned, leased, rented,
20 or otherwise legally controlled by the person; ~~or~~

21 7. When carried in a holster that is wholly or partially
22 visible or in a scabbard, case or with a sling designed for carrying
23 firearms that is wholly or partially visible and the person is
24 eighteen (18) years of age or older. Any person who carries a

1 firearm in the manner provided for in this paragraph shall be
2 prohibited from carrying the firearm into any of the places
3 prescribed in subsection A of Section 1277 of this title; or

4 8. For any legitimate purpose not in violation of the Oklahoma
5 Firearms Act of 1971 or any legislative enactment regarding the use,
6 ownership and control of firearms.

7 B. A person shall be permitted to carry unloaded shotguns,
8 rifles and pistols, open and not concealed and without a handgun
9 license as authorized by the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act pursuant to
10 the following conditions:

11 1. When going to or from the person's private residence or
12 vehicle or a vehicle in which the person is riding as a passenger to
13 a place designated or authorized for firearms repairs or
14 reconditioning, or for firearms trade, sale, or barter, or gunsmith,
15 or hunting animals or fowl, or hunter safety course, or target
16 shooting, or skeet or trap shooting or any recognized firearms
17 activity or event and while in such places; or

18 2. For any legitimate purpose not in violation of the Oklahoma
19 Firearms Act of 1971.

20 C. The provisions of this section shall not be construed to
21 prohibit educational or recreational activities, exhibitions,
22 displays or shows involving the use or display of rifles, shotguns
23 or pistols or other weapons if the activity is approved by the
24 property owner and sponsor of the activity.

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2014.
