13	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 25 O.S. 2011, Section 314, is

15	Section 314. <u>A.</u> Any person or persons willfully violating any
16	of the provisions of this act shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and
17	upon conviction shall be punished by a fine not exceeding Five
18	Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) or by imprisonment in the county jail for
19	a period not exceeding one (1) year or by both such fine and
20	imprisonment.
21	B. Any person denied access to meetings of a public body, other
22	than executive sessions pursuant to Section 307 of this title:
23	1. May bring a civil suit for declarative or injunctive relief,
2.4	or both: and

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        2. If successful, shall be entitled to reasonable attorney
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    fees.
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        C. If the public body successfully defends a civil suit and the
    court finds that the suit was clearly frivolous, the public body
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    shall be entitled to reasonable attorney fees.
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        SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2014.
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
