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12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
13	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 65 O.S. 2011, Section 3-104, is
14	amended to read as follows:
15	Section 3-104. The Director shall be the administrative,
16	executive, directing and supervising official of the Department
17	under the supervision of and in accordance with policies established
18	by the Board. He <u>The Director</u> shall:
19	(a) <u>1.</u> Approve all requisitions and claims;
20	(b) <u>2.</u> Prepare budgets;
21	$\frac{(c)}{3.}$ Prepare the staff organization and position
22	classification with the approval of the Board;
23	(d) <u>4.</u> Employ or terminate employment of all personnel as
24	provided by 74 O.S. 1961, Sections 801 - 839, as amended law; and

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(e) <u>5.</u> Make all reports, maintain all records and execute all
instruments required by law or regulation and perform all duties
necessary to discharge the functions of the Department.

The Director shall be accountable and responsible to all proper 4 5 state and federal officials for the activities of the Department. He or she shall be the representative of the state in all matters 6 pertaining to the duties and services of the Department, or any 7 other library, archival, public documents, reference, research, 8 9 records, information and information processing functions, including 10 all allied or related services, of the state government, or in which 11 the state may participate; provided that he or she may designate a 12 staff member of the Department to act as his an agent under such conditions as he may prescribe be prescribed. The Director, or any 13 designated staff member of the Department designated by him, shall 14 receive travel expense and per diem as provided by 74 O.S.1961, 15 Sections 500.5 - through 500.12, as amended of Title 74 of the 16 Oklahoma Statutes, including necessary fees incurred in the exercise 17 of his or her duties, or in attending conferences, institutes and 18 meetings of library, reference, research, documentation and 19 informational associations or bodies, or any allied or related 20 groups. 21

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2014.
SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby

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1	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
2	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
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
