10	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2011, Section 12.1, is
11	amended to read as follows:
12	Section 12.1. A person committing a felony offense listed in
13	Section 30 of this act Section 13.1 of this title on or after March
14	1, 2000, and convicted of the offense shall serve not less than
15	eighty-five percent (85%) of the sentence of imprisonment imposed
16	within the Department of Corrections. Such person shall not be
17	eligible for parole consideration prior to serving eighty-five
18	percent (85%) of the sentence imposed and such person shall not be
19	eligible for earned credits or any other type of credits which have
20	the effect of reducing the length of the sentence to less than
21	eighty-five percent (85%) of the sentence imposed.
22	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2014.
