18	Act for mileage incurred to receive or return ballots and materials
19	for the election. Judges, clerks and counters shall be paid Eighty-
20	five Dollars (\$85.00) for each election. Precinct officials
21	assigned to work a polling place ten (10) miles or more from their
22	home, shall be allowed mileage reimbursement at the rate provided by
23	the State Travel Reimbursement Act for mileage incurred from their
24	home to and from their assigned polling place. An additional Two

    Dollars ($2.00) per election shall be paid to each inspector, judge,

    clerk and counter of a precinct from the funds of the county.

    Compensation provided herein shall be paid for any state, county,

    in total the amount herein prescribed. Said compensation shall be

    paid by the State Election Board for all regular Primary, Runoff
