SENATE BILL 401

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to firearms; providing for individual firearms licensure and verification for certain purpose; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1289.30 of Title 21, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

In consideration of the fact that the right to keep and bear arms is protected and reserved to the citizen pursuant to Section 26 of Article II of the Oklahoma Constitution, a person who has not been convicted of a violent felony crime and who is lawfully able to own or possess a firearm under the Oklahoma Constitution is considered to be individually licensed and verified by the State of Oklahoma within the meaning of the provisions regarding individual licensure and verification pursuant to federal Gun-Free School Zones Act.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2013.
