SENATE BILL 452

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to public health; exempting employers from requirements to provide certain benefits in employee health insurance plans; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-728g of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Notwithstanding any other provision of state or federal law, no employer shall be required to provide or pay for any benefit or service related to abortion or contraception through the provision of health insurance to his or her employees.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2013.

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
