6	AS INTRODUCED
7	An Act relating to motor vehicles; providing for source of funds, purpose for funds and authorizing
8	expenditures from Oklahoma Association of Chiefs of Police License Plate Revolving Fund; creating
9	Oklahoma Association of Chiefs of Police License Plate Revolving Fund; amending 47 O.S. 2011, Section
10	1135.5, which relates to special license plates; providing special license plate in support of Chiefs
11	of Police; directing certain portion of fee to specified fund; providing for codification; and
12	providing an effective date.
13	
14	
15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
16	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1104.23 of Title 47, unless
18	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
19	A. Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee authorized by paragraph
20	51 of subsection B of Section 1135.5 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma
21	Statutes for Chiefs of Police license plates shall be deposited to
22	the Oklahoma Association of Chiefs of Police License Plate Revolving
23	Fund created in subsection B of this section.
24	

1 There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving в. 2 fund for the State Department of Public Safety to be designated the "Oklahoma Association of Chiefs of Police License Plate Revolving 3 Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal 4 5 year limitations, and shall consist of all monies received by the State Department of Public Safety pursuant to subsection A of this 6 section. All monies accruing to the credit of the fund are hereby 7 appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the State 8 9 Department of Public Safety to assist with funding for training and 10 education for law enforcement agencies throughout the state. 11 Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the 12 State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law with the 13 Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services for approval and payment. 14

15 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.5, is 16 amended to read as follows:

Section 1135.5. A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby
authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license
plates to persons wishing to demonstrate support and provide
financial assistance as provided by this section.

21 Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other 22 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of 23 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used

on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been
 registered for the current year with a motor license agent.

Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax
Commission or a motor license agent. The Tax Commission shall
annually notify by mail all persons issued special license plates.
The notice shall contain all necessary information and shall contain
instructions for the renewal procedure upon presentation to a motor
license agent or the Tax Commission. The license plates shall be
issued on a staggered system.

10 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a 11 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept applications for special license plates authorized under this 12 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's 13 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount 14 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary 15 information directly into such system and generate a receipt 16 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents 17 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for 18 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for 19 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the 20 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund. 21

If fewer than one hundred of any type of special license plates authorized prior to January 1, 2004, are issued prior to January 1, 24 2006, the Tax Commission shall discontinue issuance and renewal of

1 that type of special license plate. Any such authorized special 2 license plate registrant shall be allowed to display the license 3 plate upon the designated vehicle until the registration expiration 4 date. After such time the expired special license plate shall be 5 removed from the vehicle.

For special license plates authorized on or after July 1, 2004, 6 no special license plates shall be developed or issued by the Tax 7 Commission until the Commission receives one hundred prepaid 8 9 applications therefor. The prepaid applications must be received by 10 the Tax Commission within one hundred and eighty (180) days of the 11 effective date of the authorization or the authority to issue shall 12 be null and void. In the event one hundred prepaid applications are not received by the Tax Commission within such prescribed time 13 period any payment so received shall be refunded accordingly. 14

B. The special license plates provided by this section are as follows:

University or College Supporter License Plates - such plates
 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
 support to any state-supported or private university or college. As
 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
 apportioned as provided in Section 1104.1 of this title;

2. Environmental Awareness License Plates - such plates shall
 be designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax
 Commission by the Department of Environmental Quality in

1 consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any 2 person wishing to demonstrate support to implement the statewide 3 general public environmental education program created pursuant to the provisions of the Oklahoma Environmental Quality Code. 4 Such 5 plates shall be designed and issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for 6 personalized license plates. A dealer's license plate issued 7 pursuant to Section 1116.1 or 1128 of this title may be designated 8 9 an Environmental Awareness License Plate upon payment of the fee 10 imposed by this section and any other registration fees required by 11 the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. As provided in 12 this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned pursuant to Section 1104.2 of this title; 13

Firefighter License Plates - such plates shall be designed 14 3. for any career or retired firefighter, volunteer or paid. 15 Firefighters may apply for firefighter plates for up to four 16 vehicles with a rated capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a 17 motorcycle upon proof of a fire department membership by either an 18 identification card or letter from the chief of the fire department. 19 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of 20 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to 21 provide proof of eligibility annually. The surviving spouse of any 22 deceased firefighter, if the spouse has not since remarried, may 23 apply for a firefighter license plate for one vehicle with a rated 24

1 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a motorcycle upon 2 proof that the deceased firefighter was a member of a fire 3 department by either an identification card or letter from the chief 4 of the fire department.

5 Except for motorcycles, the license plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma" in the color Pantone 186C Red and shall contain no more 6 than three letters and three numbers in the color Pantone 301C Blue. 7 Between the letters and numbers shall be the Firefighter Maltese 8 9 Cross Logo in the color Pantone 186C Red outlined in the color 10 Pantone 301C Blue. Below the letters and the logo shall be the word 11 "Firefighter" in the color Pantone 186C Red. The license plate for 12 motorcycles may be of a similar design as space permits or a new 13 design in order to meet the space requirements of a motorcycle license plate. The plates shall not be subject to the design 14 requirements of any other license plates prescribed by law other 15 than the space for the placement of the yearly decals for each 16 succeeding year of registration after the initial issue. 17

As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited to the Oklahoma State Firemen's Museum Building & Memorial Fund for support of the Oklahoma Firefighter Fallen and Living Memorial;

4. Wildlife Conservation License Plates - such plates shall be
designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax
Commission by the Oklahoma Department of Wildlife Conservation in

1 consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any 2 person wishing to demonstrate support for wildlife conservation in 3 this state through the Wildlife Diversity Fund, provided for in 4 Section 3-310 of Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes. Such plates may 5 be designed and issued to any person as for personalized license 6 plates.

As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
shall be apportioned pursuant to subsection D of Section 3-310 of
Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

5. Child Abuse Prevention License Plates - such plates shall be
designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax
Commission by the Office of Child Abuse Prevention in the State
Department of Health and the Oklahoma Committee to Prevent Child
Abuse, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
the prevention of child abuse.

As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Child Abuse Prevention Fund;

6. United States Olympic Committee Supporter License Plates such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the United States Olympic Committee. The plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates. The plate shall contain the official United States Olympic Committee logo. The Tax Commission shall be authorized, if

necessary, to enter into a licensing agreement with the United States Olympic Committee for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use the United States Olympic Committee logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment of not more than Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for each license plate issued;

7 7. Oklahoma History License Plates - such plates shall be
8 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate interest in
9 Oklahoma history. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee
10 collected shall be deposited to the Oklahoma Historical Society
11 Revolving Fund to be used for educational purposes;

8. Historic Route 66 License Plates - such plates shall be
designed to honor historic Route 66, also known as the "Mother
Road". As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
shall be apportioned to the Oklahoma Historical Society Revolving
Fund to be distributed to the Route 66 Museum located in Clinton,
Oklahoma;

9. Heart of the Heartland License Plates - such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to honor the victims of the terrorist bombing attack on the Alfred P. Murrah Federal Building in downtown Oklahoma City on April 19, 1995. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Heart of the Heartland Scholarship Fund, as established in Section 2282 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

1 10. Emergency Medical Technician License Plates - such plates 2 shall be designed and issued to any person who is an emergency 3 medical technician. Such persons may apply for an emergency medical technician license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying 4 5 capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of an emergency medical technician's license. The license plate shall be designed in 6 consultation with the state association of emergency medical 7 technicians. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee 8 9 collected shall be apportioned to the Emergency Medical Technician 10 Death Benefit Revolving Fund created in Section 1-2505.2 of Title 63 11 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

12 11. Fight Breast Cancer License Plates - such plates shall be 13 designed to demonstrate support for the prevention and treatment of 14 breast cancer in this state. As provided in this section, an amount 15 of the fee collected shall be apportioned to the Breast Cancer Act 16 Revolving Fund;

12. Crime Victims Awareness License Plates - such plates shall 17 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate 18 awareness of and support for victims of crimes. The license plates 19 shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Crime Victims 20 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected 21 Centre. shall be apportioned to the Attorney General's Revolving Fund for 22 the Office of the Attorney General, which is hereby directed to use 23

1 such funds to contract with a statewide nonprofit organization to
2 provide services to crime victims;

3 13. Oklahoma Safe Kids Association License Plates - such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate 4 5 support and awareness of the Oklahoma Safe Kids Association. The license plate shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma 6 Safe Kids Association. As provided in this section, an amount of 7 the fee collected shall be deposited in the Children's Hospital -8 9 Oklahoma Safe Kids Association Revolving Fund to be distributed to 10 the Oklahoma Safe Kids Association program;

Four-H Club License Plates - such plates shall be designed, 11 14. 12 subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission by the Four-H Foundation, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate 13 support of the Four-H Club. Such plates may be designed and issued 14 15 to any person as for personalized license plates. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned to 16 17 the OSU Extension Service License Plate Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.4 of this title; 18

19 15. Agricultural Awareness License Plates - such plates shall 20 be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax 21 Commission, by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and 22 Forestry in consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued 23 to any person wishing to demonstrate support of the Department's Ag 24 in the Classroom Education Program. As provided in this section, an

1 amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in 2 Section 1104.3 of this title;

3 16. Oklahoma Statehood Centennial License Plates - such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to commemorate 4 5 the centennial of Oklahoma's admission to statehood in 1907. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma 6 Capitol Complex and Centennial Commemoration Commission. 7 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be 8 9 deposited in the Oklahoma Capitol Complex and Centennial 10 Commemoration Commission Revolving Fund created in Section 98.5 of Title 73 of the Oklahoma Statutes; 11

12 17. Support Education License Plates - such plates shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission 13 by the State Department of Education in consultation with the 14 Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any person wishing to 15 demonstrate support for education in this state. All motor license 16 agents shall display a sample of the Support Education License plate 17 in the area of the business accessed by the public. Twenty-three 18 Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee collected shall be apportioned as 19 20 follows:

a. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Education
 Reform Revolving Fund,

b. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Higher
Education Revolving Fund,

- c. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the State
 Career Technology Fund, and
- d. eighty-five percent (85%) of the fee shall be
 deposited to the Teachers' Retirement Benefit Fund as
 set forth in Section 17-108 of Title 70 of the
 Oklahoma Statutes.

However, when the Teachers' Retirement Benefit Fund attains a seventy percent (70%) funded ratio based on an annual actuarial valuation as required by law, the amount of the fee shall be apportioned equally pursuant to subparagraphs a, b and c of this paragraph;

12 18. Retired Oklahoma Highway Patrol Officers License Plates such plates shall be designed and issued to any retired officer of 13 the Oklahoma Highway Patrol. The license plate shall have the 14 15 legend "Oklahoma" and shall contain, in the center of the plate, the Highway Patrol Officers patch using the same colors and pattern as 16 used in the patch. Centered on the bottom of the license plate 17 shall be the word "Retired". The letters "TRP" shall be used in 18 combination with three numbers on either side of the insignia or 19 emblem. The color of the letters and numbers shall be brown. 20 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of 21 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to 22 provide proof of eligibility annually. The surviving spouse of any 23 deceased retired officer of the Oklahoma Highway Patrol, if the 24

spouse has not since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a Retired Oklahoma Highway Patrol Officers license plate. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited into the Law Enforcement Retirement Fund;

Boy Scouts of America Supporter License Plates - such 6 19. plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to 7 demonstrate support for the Boy Scouts of America. The plates shall 8 9 be issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters 10 from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates. 11 The plate shall contain the official Boy Scouts of America logo. 12 The Tax Commission shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into a licensing agreement with the Boy Scouts of America for any 13 licensing fees which may be required in order to use the Boy Scouts 14 of America logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide 15 for a payment to the Boy Scouts of America of not more than Twenty 16 Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued; 17

20. Urban Forestry and Beautification License Plates - such plates shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission, by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry in consultation with nonprofit organizations in this state that develop and operate programs to encourage urban forestry and beautification, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support of such programs. As provided in this section, an amount of

1 the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in Section 1104.5
2 of this title;

3 21. Oklahoma State Parks Supporter License Plates - such plates shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax 4 5 Commission by the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma 6 state parks system. Twenty-three Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee 7 collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation 8 9 Department Revolving Fund. Such money shall be designated for and 10 may only be expended for the support of Oklahoma state parks;

11 22. Adoption Creates Families License Plates - such plates 12 shall be issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support of 13 pregnant women who are committed to placing their children for adoption and wishing to provide assistance to guardians, adoptive 14 parents and other created families to assist in the adoption and 15 placement of children in permanent, safe homes. The license plates 16 17 shall be designed and final terminology delivered in consultation with the Oklahoma Adoption Coalition and the Department of Human 18 Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) of the fee collected shall 19 Services. be deposited in a revolving fund established in the State Treasury 20 for and to be used by the Department of Human Services for the 21 implementation of the Investing in Stronger Oklahoma Families Act 22 specifically for created families; 23

23. Choose Life License Plates - such plates shall be designed, 1 2 subject to criteria presented to the Tax Commission, by Choose Life, 3 Inc., and issued to any person who wishes to demonstrate support of organizations that encourage adoption as a positive choice for women 4 5 with unplanned pregnancies. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Choose Life 6 Assistance Program Revolving Fund established in Section 1104.6 of 7 this title; 8

9 24. Future Farmers of America License Plate - such plates shall 10 be designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for 11 the Oklahoma FFA (formerly known as Future Farmers of America). The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma 12 FFA Foundation Board of Directors. As provided in this section, an 13 amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in 14 Section 1104.7 of this title; 15

Lions Club License Plates - such plates shall be designed 16 25. and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for the Lions 17 Club of Oklahoma. The plates shall be issued to any person in any 18 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, 19 as for personalized license plates. The license plates shall be 20 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Lions Service Foundation 21 and shall contain the official logo of the International Association 22 of Lions Clubs. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter 23 into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma Lions Service 24

Foundation. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to
 the Oklahoma Lions Service Foundation of not more than Ten Dollars
 (\$10.00) for each license plate issued;

26. Color Oklahoma License Plates - such plates shall be 4 5 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission by the Oklahoma Native Plant Society, and issued to any person 6 wishing to demonstrate support for preserving and planting 7 wildflowers and native plants in Oklahoma and to promote Oklahoma's 8 9 wildflower heritage through education. As provided in this section, 10 an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in Section 1104.8 of this title; 11

12 27. Girl Scouts of the United States of America Supporter License Plates - such plates shall be designed and issued to any 13 person wishing to demonstrate support for the Girl Scouts of the 14 15 United States of America. The plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of 16 seven, as for personalized license plates. The plate shall contain 17 the official Girl Scouts of the United States of America logo. 18 The Tax Commission shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into a 19 licensing agreement with the Girl Scouts of the United States of 20 America for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use 21 the Girl Scouts of the United States of America logo or design. 22 The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the Girl Scouts 23 of Magic Empire Council, acting on behalf of all Oklahoma Girl Scout 24

1 councils, of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license
2 plate issued;

3 28. Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon License Plates - such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to 4 5 demonstrate support for the Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon. The plate shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma City 6 The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter Memorial Marathon. 7 into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon 8 9 for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use the 10 Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon logo or design. The licensing 11 agreement shall provide for a payment to the Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license 12 13 plate issued;

14 29. Oklahoma Scenic Rivers License Plate - such plates shall be 15 designed to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma Scenic Rivers. The 16 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Scenic 17 Rivers Commission. Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) of the fee shall be 18 apportioned to the Oklahoma Scenic Rivers Commission;

30. Fight Cancer License Plate - such plates shall be designed
to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma Central Cancer Registry.
The plate shall contain the American Cancer Society logo. The
American Cancer Society logo shall be used in accordance with the
American Cancer Society's branding guidelines and shall only be
utilized to support the Oklahoma Central Cancer Registry. Twenty

Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee shall be apportioned to the Oklahoma
 Central Cancer Registry Revolving Fund;

3 31. Animal Friendly License Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for 4 5 controlling the overpopulation of dogs and cats through educational and sterilization efforts. The plates shall be designed in 6 consultation with the Veterinary Medical Association. Twenty 7 Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee collected shall be designated by the 8 9 purchaser of the plate to be deposited in the Oklahoma Pet 10 Overpopulation Fund created in Section 2368.13 of Title 68 of the 11 Oklahoma Statutes or the Animal Friendly Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.10 of this title; 12

32. Patriot License Plate - such plates shall be designed in 13 consultation with the Military Department of Oklahoma and issued to 14 15 any person wishing to demonstrate support for Oklahoma residents who are members of the Oklahoma National Guard and deployed on active 16 The plates shall be issued to any person in any combination 17 dutv. of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for 18 personalized license plates. As provided in this section, a portion 19 of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Patriot License Plate 20 Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.11 of this title; 21

33. Global War on Terrorism License Plate - such plate shall be
designed in consultation with the Military Department of Oklahoma
and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for Oklahoma

1 residents who are members of the Armed Forces of the United States or Oklahoma National Guard that have served in the Global War on 2 3 Terrorism. The plate shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of six. 4 As 5 provided in this section, a portion of the fee collected shall be deposited in the 45th Infantry Division Museum Fund created in 6 Section 235.1 of Title 44 of the Oklahoma Statutes; 7

34. Boys and Girls Clubs of America Supporter License Plates -8 9 such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to 10 demonstrate support for the Boys and Girls Clubs of America. The 11 plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers 12 and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates. The plate shall contain the official Boys and Girls 13 Clubs of America logo. The Tax Commission, if necessary, may enter 14 15 into a licensing agreement with the Boys and Girls Clubs of America for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use the 16 Boys and Girls Clubs of America logo or design. The licensing 17 agreement shall provide for a payment to the Boys and Girls Clubs of 18 America of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license 19 plate issued; 20

35. Oklahoma Quarter Horse License Plates - such plates shall
be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
for the American Quarter Horse in Oklahoma. The plate shall be
designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Quarter Horse

Association. As provided in this section, a portion of the fee
 collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Quarter Horse Revolving
 Fund created in Section 1104.12 of this title;

Oklahoma Association for the Deaf License Plate - such 36. 4 5 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Association for the Deaf and issued to any person wishing to 6 demonstrate support for Oklahoma residents who are deaf. The plates 7 shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers and 8 9 letters from one to maximum of seven, as for personalized license 10 plates.
