If one or more of the state pension systems has a funded ratio of less than ninety percent (90%), the Oklahoma Pension Stabilization Fund shall be allocated, by legislative appropriation, to reduce the unfunded liability of any one or any combination of state pension systems. Priority shall be given to the pension system with the lowest funded ratio.
 - D. Any amounts not appropriated by the Legislature pursuant to subsection C of this section shall revert to the fund from which they came unless otherwise allocated by the Legislature.
- SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2013.
 - SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
