She also was a finalist for the 7 2001 Oklahoma Teacher of the Year, as well as the Shell Science 8 9 Teaching Award in 2008; and

10 WHEREAS, she serves as the grant writer and director for the 11 Mathematics and Science partnership program in Pontotoc County, and 12 is active in the National Science Teachers Association; and 13 WHEREAS, Deborah Cornelison holds a bachelor's degree in 14 biology, a master's degree in education from East Central University 15 (ECU) and is nationally-certified in adolescent and young adulthood 16 science; and

WHEREAS, she served as an adjunct instructor of biology and physical science at ECU for 3.5 years and taught science in the college's Upward Bound programs for 16 years; and
