SENATE JOINT
RESOLUTION 30

AS INTRODUCED

A Joint Resolution directing the Secretary of State to refer to the people for their approval or rejection a proposed amendment to Section 2 of Article VII of the Oklahoma Constitution; establishing limitations on certain terms; providing ballot title; and directing filing.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE
1ST SESSION OF THE 54TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law, the following proposed amendment to Section 2 of Article VII of the Oklahoma Constitution to read as follows:

Section 2. The Supreme Court shall consist of nine Justices until the number shall be changed by statute and each Justice shall be from a separate district of the State. Each district shall remain as presently constituted until otherwise provided by Statute. The terms of office of the Justices of the Supreme Court shall be six (6) years and shall commence on the second Monday of January following their election. No justice shall serve more than twelve

1 (12) years on the Court. Those appointed or elected to fill
2 vacancies shall assume office immediately upon qualifying for the
3 office. Each Justice, at the time of ~~his~~ election or appointment,
4 shall have attained the age of thirty (30) years, shall have been a
5 qualified elector in the district for at least one (1) year
6 immediately prior to the date of filing or appointment, and shall
7 have been a licensed practicing attorney or judge of a court of
8 record, or both, in Oklahoma for five (5) years preceding ~~his~~
9 election or appointment and shall continue to be a duly licensed
10 attorney while in office to be eligible to hold the office. The
11 Justices shall choose from among their members a Chief Justice and a
12 Vice Chief Justice.

13 SECTION 2. The Ballot Title for the proposed Constitutional
14 amendment as set forth in SECTION 1 of this resolution shall be in
15 the following form:

18 THE GIST OF THE PROPOSITION IS AS FOLLOWS:

19 This measure amends Section 2 of Article 7 of the State
20 Constitution. This measure limits a Supreme Court Justice to
21 serving not more than twelve years on the Court.
