1 The Legislature shall also meet in regular session at the seat of government on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in January 2 of each odd numbered year, beginning at twelve o'clock noon for the 3 purposes only of performing the duties as required by Section 5 of 5 Article VI of the Constitution and organizing pursuant to the provisions of this Article and shall recess not later than five 6 o'clock p.m. of that same day until the following first Monday in 7 February of the same year, beginning at twelve o'clock noon. 9 SECTION 2. The Ballot Title for the proposed Constitutional amendment as set forth in SECTION 1 of this resolution shall be in 10 11 the following form: 12 BALLOT TITLE Legislative Referendum No. State Question No. 13 THE GIST OF THE PROPOSITION IS AS FOLLOWS: 14 This measure amends Section 26 of Article 5 of the State 15 Constitution. It would require the Legislature to meet in 16 regular sessions in only odd-numbered years.
