10	An Act relating to the Oklahoma Educational			
11	Television Authority; making an appropriation; stating purpose; providing for the budgeting of funds			
12	in certain categories and amounts; requiring certain performance measures for budget categories; providing			
13	for duties and compensation of employees of the Oklahoma Educational Television Authority; limiting the maximum salary of the Director; providing budgetary limitations; requiring budgeting of certain

15	funds in certain years; requiring certain budget procedures; prohibiting certain budget procedures;			
16	providing lapse dates; and providing an effective date.

19	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:			
20	SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma			
21	Educational Television Authority from any monies not otherwise			
22	appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for			
23	the fiscal year ending June 30, 2014, the sum of			
24	Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform			

the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Educational Television
 Authority by law.

3 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2014, the
4 Oklahoma Educational Television Authority shall budget all funds in
5 the following categories and amounts:

11 The Authority shall develop outcome-based performance measures 12 for each budget category.

13 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not 14 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed 15 upon the Oklahoma Educational Television Authority by law shall be 16 set by the Director. The salary of the Director shall not exceed 17 Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for the 18 fiscal year ending June 30, 2014. The Oklahoma Educational 19 Television Authority for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2014, shall 20 be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-21 equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for 22 capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant 23 to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma 24 Statutes:

4 SECTION 4. Appropriations made by this act, not including 5 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2014 (hereafter FY-14) or may be 6 7 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2015 (hereafter FY-15). 8 Funds budgeted for FY-14 may be encumbered only through June 30, 9 2014, and must be expended by November 15, 2014. Any funds 10 remaining after November 15, 2014, and not budgeted for FY-15, shall 11 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal 12 year. Funds budgeted for FY-15 may be encumbered only through June 13 30, 2015. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2015, shall lapse 14 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year. 15 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years 16 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-14, and not required to pay 17 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-15, after 18 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared 19 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds 20 from the FY-14 budget work program and after such revision has been 21 approved by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services. 22 SECTION 5. This act shall become effective September 1, 2013.
