AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to elections; requiring costs for certain elections be printed on public communications and ballots; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6-104.1 of Title 26, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The costs and expenditures for any municipal or school district bond election shall be printed on any public communication thirty (30) days prior to the date of the bond election. The costs and expenditures for any municipal or school district bond election shall also be printed on any ballot, including absentee ballots, used for the bond election.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2013.

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
