L 6	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
L7	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 291 of Title 17, unless there is

3. "Incumbent electric transmission owner" means any Oklahoma electric public utility, as recognized by the Commission, or its affiliates, any electric cooperative, any municipal power agency, or any municipal utility that owns, operates and maintains an electric transmission line in this state; and

- 4. "Southwest Power Pool" means the Southwest Power Pool or any federally recognized successor entity.
- SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 292 of Title 17, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

An incumbent electric transmission owner has the right to construct, own and maintain an electric transmission line that has been approved for construction in a Southwest Power Pool transmission plan and will interconnect to facilities owned by that incumbent electric transmission owner. The right to construct, own and maintain an electric transmission line that will interconnect to facilities owned by two or more incumbent electric transmission owners belongs individually and proportionally to each incumbent electric transmission owner, unless otherwise agreed upon in writing.

SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 293 of Title 17, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

- A. If the Southwest Power Pool has approved an electric transmission line in a Southwest Power Pool transmission plan and has formally directed the incumbent electric transmission owner or owners, if there is more than one owner, to construct the electric transmission line, the incumbent electric transmission owner or owners shall give notice to the Southwest Power Pool, in writing, within ninety (90) days of receipt of the direction to construct by the Southwest Power Pool, regarding its intent to construct, own and maintain the electric transmission line. If notice is not provided, the incumbent electric transmission owner shall surrender its right to construct, own and maintain the electric transmission line.
- B. If an incumbent electric transmission owner or owners gives notice of intent not to build the electric transmission line or fails to provide notice as required in subsection A of this section, then the Southwest Power Pool may determine whether the incumbent electric transmission owner or other entity will build the electric transmission line.

SECTION 4. This act shall become effective November 1, 2013.
