Management and Enterprise Services the Construction and Properties
Division Department of Real Estate Services. There is hereby
created within the <del>Division</del> Department the position of State
Construction Administrator Facilities Director who shall be the
chief administrative officer of the <del>Division</del> Department.
Administrator State Facilities Director shall be a registered
professional engineer or, a licensed architect or an individual
credentialed and experienced in the field of real property
administration who shall be appointed by and serve at the pleasure
of the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services.
The <u>State Facilities</u> Director shall employ or contract with experts
and consultants as are necessary to perform the duties of the
Division Department.
