19	SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
20	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 650.12 of Title 21, unless there
21	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
22	A. Every person who, without justifiable or excusable cause,
23	knowingly commits any assault upon the person of a social worker or
24	child welfare worker duly employed by the Department of Human

Services to enforce state laws while the worker is in the performance of employment duties, upon conviction, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment in the county jail not exceeding six (6) months, or by a fine not exceeding Five Hundred Dollars ($500.00), or by both fine and imprisonment.
```

B. Every person who, without justifiable or excusable cause knowingly commits battery or assault and battery upon the person of a social worker or child welfare worker duly employed by the Department of Human Services to enforce state laws while the worker is in the performance of employment duties, upon conviction, shall be guilty of a felony punishable by imprisonment of not more than five (5) years in a state correctional institution or county jail for a period not to exceed one (1) year, or by a fine not exceeding Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), or by both fine and imprisonment.

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2013.
