5 AS INTRODUCED

6 An Act relating to elections; amending 26 O.S. 2011,
7 Section 1-103, which relates to runoff primary
8 elections; bypassing runoff primary elections under
9 certain circumstances; and providing an effective
10 date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 26 O.S. 2011, Section 1-103, is
14 amended to read as follows:

15 Section 1-103. If at any Primary Election no candidate for the
16 nomination for office of any political party receives a majority of
17 all votes cast for all candidates of such party for the office, ~~no~~
18 ~~candidate shall be nominated by such party for the office, but the~~
19 ~~two candidates~~ candidate receiving the highest number of votes at
20 such election shall be placed on the official ballot as ~~candidates~~
21 the candidate for such nomination at a ~~Runoff Primary Election to be~~
22 ~~held on the fourth Tuesday of August in the same year~~ the General
23 Election, unless three or more Runoff Primary Elections can be held
24 at the same time as determined by the county election board. No

1 county, municipality or school district shall schedule an election
2 on any date during the twenty (20) days immediately preceding the
3 date of any such Runoff Primary Election.

4 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2013.
