FA1 for HB 1035 relates to the Oklahoma School Testing Program and annual reports. Regarding schools comprised of high school grades, the amendment concerns the assessment percentage cap and the calculation of a school's performance grade if a school had a number of students with disabilities enrolled for the full academic year in the school who participated in the Oklahoma Alternative Assessment Program or the Oklahoma Modified Alternative Assessment Program. Department of Education personnel provide that there is the potential loss of federal funds.
