## **Research Analysis**

HB 1056 creates the Parole of Aging Prisoners Act. The measure would authorize aging prisoners, age 65 or older to request a parole hearing after the completion of 10 years of incarceration or 1/3<sup>rd</sup> of their prison sentence. The Pardon and Parole Board is required to grant parole to a prisoner if the Board finds that the person can live and remain at liberty without posing a substantial risk to public safety. The Board is required to use an evidence-based risk assessment to make the determination.
