Fiscal Analysis

According to the Department of Corrections (DOC), there are currently 685 incarcerated offenders who are 65 years of age or older and not serving a Life, Life without Parole or Death sentence, and not serving a 85% sentence or a violent sentence and have served one third or more of their current sentence.

Every inmate that is released on conditional parole will save the state approximately \$46 per day on prison costs. The state would incur some costs for supervision and possibly mental health treatment and other support services. The amount of savings would be dependent upon the number of inmates released on conditional parole and the cost of any support services provided.
