**Research Analysis**

The committee substitute for HB 1067 requires a peace officer who comes into contact with a human trafficking victim to inform the victim of the human trafficking hotline number and give notice to the victim of certain rights. The measure provides that in any prosecution of a person sixteen or seventeen years of age for a prostitution related offense, there shall be a presumption that the person was coerced into committing the offense by another person in violation of human trafficking.
