Research Analysis

Senate Amendment to HB 1384 does not make any significant substantive changes to the engrossed bill, which outlines the rights of parents to direct the upbringing of their children, including making healthcare decisions and consenting prior to various tests or procedures being administered or recordings made. The measure delineates responsibilities of boards of education to develop policies to promote the involvement of parents in various facets of their children's education. Violation of certain provisions is a misdemeanor.
