Research Analysis

HB 1557 creates the Geolocation Information Protection Act. The measure provides definitions used in the act. The Act provides that it is unlawful to intentionally intercept or procure geolocation information pertaining to another person or to disclose any other person's geolocation information that was illegally obtained. Provides that punishment for violation of the act is a felony, punishable by a term of not less than 1 year in the county jail, a fine of not less than \$1,000 or both fine and imprisonment. The measure provides exceptions to violation. Allows a person whose geolocation information has been intercepted to file a civil action.
