**Research Analysis**

Introduced HB1876 authorizes any county to levy up to seven percent severance tax on the gross value of the production of rock, gravel, sand and gypsum through a special election approved by a majority of the registered voter in the respective county. The special election may be called by the board of county commissioners or by an initiative petition signed by 5% percent of the registered voters in the county. Finally, the measure requires the proceeds from the severance tax to be deposited into the county highway fund.
