**Research Analysis**

The SAHB for HB 2165 sets certain requirements that must be met in order for telecommunication carriers to receive reimbursements from the Oklahoma Lifeline Fund. The measure requires carriers to obtain certain customer information. The measure allows the Corporation Commission to assess fines up to \$10,000 per violation. The measure includes an emergency clause.

**Fiscal Analysis**

SAHB for HB 2165 provides authorization to the Corporation Commission for the establishment and receipt of fine revenue for violations involving the Lifeline program. The measure authorizes fines of up to \$10,000 per violation per day, although most fines would likely be less. The amount of revenue would be dependent upon the number of violations and the amounts of fines.
