Research Analysis

The measure allows school districts, except when there are time constraints as determined by the superintendent, to make a request to the State board of Education that a national criminal history record check be conducted of any prospective volunteer. The Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation will obtain fingerprints and require that the school district pay a fee not to exceed \$50 or the cost of the search, whichever is less. After a volunteer passes the check, the individual will not be required to submit to additional checks unless required by a policy adopted by the board of education. Prospective volunteer is defined as a parent, guardian or any individual who will have direct contact with students.
